

## Terms & Conditions

### Article 1 – General

1. These Competition Terms and Conditions (hereinafter the "Contest") apply to the promotional campaign organised by Stellantis Belux, whose registered office is located at Avenue du Bourget 20/2, 1130 Brussels, Belgium, registered under company number BE0403.461.107 (hereinafter "FIAT" or the "Organisers"). For the execution of this Competition, FIAT has appointed The Friends by Verhulst, whose registered office is located at Parc Industriel 37A, 1440 Wauthier-Braine, Belgium, registered under company number BE0427.256.492 (hereinafter "The Friends").
2. Participation in the Contest constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Failure by a participant to comply with these Terms and Conditions will automatically result in the invalidation of their participation and, where applicable, the forfeiture of any prize, without any liability on the part of the Organisers and without entitlement to any form of compensation. Participation in the Competition is only possible in accordance with the procedures described in these Terms and Conditions.

### Article 2 – Eligibility

1. Participation in the Contest is open exclusively to natural persons who are at least 18 years old, reside in Belgium, and hold a valid driving licence.
2. Participation is strictly personal and may not be transferred or assigned to any third party.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to exclude any person participating in the Competition through organised collaboration, whether as part of a legal entity, a de facto association, or any other arrangement intended to increase the chances of winning, as well as any participant suspected of fraudulent behaviour.
4. Employees, collaborators and staff members of FIAT and The Friends who have been involved in the organisation of this Competition are not eligible to participate.

### Article 3 – Participation Procedure

1. The Competition is valid exclusively in Belgium and only at the Art Unity Gallery Concept Store.
2. The Competition runs from **1 July 2026** until **31 August 2026 at 11:59 PM (midnight)**.
3. To participate, participants must visit the Art Unity Gallery Concept Store and register for a test drive with one of the two FIAT vehicles on display. As part of the registration process, participants will be required to provide certain personal information, including their title, first name, last name and email address. Participants warrant that all information provided is accurate, complete and up to date.
4. Upon successful registration, participants will automatically be entered into the Competition for a chance to win a **€250 voucher** redeemable towards the purchase of an artwork from the selection presented by Art Unity Gallery. The voucher will be

sent to the winner by email and will remain valid until **12 October 2026**, the closing date of the Art Unity Gallery Concept Store.

#### **Article 4 – The Contest**

1. Each registration for a test drive between **1 July 2026** and **31 August 2026** automatically grants one entry into the contest for a chance to win a **€250 voucher**, redeemable towards the purchase of an artwork of the winner's choice from the Art Unity Gallery selection.
2. Participation in the contest must take place within the period referred to in **Article 3**. Only entries submitted during this period will be considered valid. When registering for a test drive, participants will be invited to complete the contest entry form.
3. By submitting their entry, each participant confirms that they have read the full Terms & Conditions and the rules governing the contest and agree to be bound by them.
4. Each valid entry entitles the participant to answer one main question and one tie-breaker question.

#### **Article 5 – Selection of Winners and Awarding of Prizes**

1. A winner will be selected from among the participants who have complied with all the conditions of the contest:
  - o The participant must have validly registered for both a test drive and the contest by completing the required personal information and submitting the completed entry form to the representative at the Art Unity Gallery Concept Store.
  - o The participant must have answered both the main question and the tie-breaker question.

If no participant provides the correct answer to the tie-breaker question, the winner will be the participant who answered the main question correctly and whose answer to the tie-breaker question is closest to the correct answer. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the participant who submitted the correct entry first.

2. A total of **eight (8) winners** will be selected.
3. Winners will be contacted by **The Friends** via email during the week following the end of each contest period. Their €250 Art Unity Gallery voucher will be sent in the same email.
4. The prize is personal, non-transferable and may not be exchanged for cash or any other goods or services.
5. If a winner refuses the prize, fails to claim it, or does not respond to the Organisers' notification within the specified timeframe, for any reason whatsoever, the prize will be forfeited and returned to the Organisers. The winner shall not be entitled to any compensation.
6. If the email address provided by the winner is incorrect, or if the prize is not claimed within one month after the end of the Prize Draw for reasons not attributable to the Organisers, the winner will forfeit all rights to the prize, which shall remain the property of the Organisers. No compensation of any kind shall be due.

## Article 6 – Liability

1. The Organisers reserve the right, should circumstances so require, to shorten, extend, amend, suspend or cancel the Prize Draw or these Terms & Conditions at any time without incurring any liability. The Organisers shall not be liable for any direct or indirect loss, damage, cost or expense arising from participation in the contest or from the awarding, acceptance or use of any prize.
2. Participants acknowledge that they take part in the contest entirely at their own risk.
3. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, participants waive any non-contractual liability claims against FIAT and/or its directors, employees, shareholders or affiliated companies arising from or in connection with the contest
4. Any costs incurred in connection with participation in the contest shall be borne solely by the participants. Under no circumstances may participants claim reimbursement of such costs from the Organisers.
5. The Organisers shall not be held liable for incorrect, incomplete or inaccurate information provided by participants, including invalid or incorrect email addresses.
6. If the contest is cancelled due to force majeure, the Organisers shall not be held liable under any circumstances.
7. The Organisers shall not be liable for:
  - o any event of force majeure or any decision by public authorities preventing the winner from enjoying or redeeming the prize;
  - o any accident, loss, delay, cost or damage of any kind arising from participation in the contest or from the awarding, receipt or use of the prize;
  - o any loss or delay caused by third parties;
  - o any additional expenses, accommodation costs or transportation costs other than those expressly stated in these Terms & Conditions as being covered by the Organisers;
  - o the winner's inability to redeem the prize due to a decision of the authorities, refusal by the authorities, failure to appear at the required time, or the absence or invalidity of any visa, passport or other required travel document;
  - o the winner's inability to redeem the prize due to health-related restrictions, including quarantine measures or a positive COVID-19 test, where applicable.

## Article 7 – Personal Data

For the purpose of administering the contest **Stellantis**, acting as the data controller, and **The Friends**, acting as the data processor, process participants' personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection legislation and Stellantis' Privacy Policy.

The following personal data will be processed for the purposes of administering the contest : first name, last name, language, title, date of birth, email address, date and time of participation, number of entries, answers to the main and tie-breaker questions, and prize details (for winners only).

As the personal data is collected on paper entry forms, it will not be retained after the end of the contest. Only the email addresses of the winners will be retained for the sole purpose of sending them their prize voucher.

Participants also enjoy all rights granted to them under the applicable data protection legislation, including the right to object to the processing of their personal data. Please note, however, that if a participant requests the deletion of their personal data or objects to its processing before the contest has been completed, their participation will be cancelled. Participants agree that the Organisers may verify their identity and the information provided. Any false, inaccurate or misleading identity or contact information will automatically result in disqualification from the contest

#### **Article 8 – Governing Law and Jurisdiction**

These Terms & Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Belgium.

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with these Terms & Conditions or the contest that cannot be settled amicably shall fall within the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Brussels, Belgium.
